2009 BASEBALL SEASON OUTLOOK

The Vanguard University Baseball program will begin the 2009 season with a new Head Coach in Ralph Grajeda. Beginning a new era within one of VU's oldest sports programs, Grajeda's goal is to get the team back to the level of the very successful late 1980's teams at VU and beyond. His first steps included securing a blended coaching staff with the return of veteran pitching coach Randy Wishmyer and the addition of young assistants Josh Tavelli and Eric Pfohl. Grajeda, his coaching staff, and players, poured time, work, and money into the existing field at Vanguard during the fall semester as his next order of business to improve the facilities for the Lions. The field improvements are very tangible and visible to anyone taking note, however, his next challenge will be to place a team out on that field that can compete in the difficult Golden State Athletic Conference. Notching a 72-110 overall record during the past four seasons under former head coach Scott Mallernee, the Lions are coming off a dismal 17-31 record in 2008. VU was 8-28 in GSAC and finished ninth among ten teams, missing the playoffs for the sixth year in a row. Grajeda has 7 returning starters and 16 letterwinners returning from the 2008 team, and has added 13 transfers to the mix. A roster of nearly 30 players in his first season should give Grajeda some depth as half of the returning players are pitchers and combined to win all but one of VU's games in 2009. Four-year seniors Zach Leighton, Derek Craddock, Rich Jessup, Sonny Behrends, and Ethan Gentry would like to leave the Lion program on a winning note. Jessup and Chris Carls were VU's top performers on the mound in 2008 and will be keys to Vanguard's success in 2009 as well. Go Lions!
