## 2009 Season Outlook

Randy Dodge has accumulated an overall record of 78-46-8 in his first seven seasons directing Vanguard's men's soccer program. Coming off a third-place finish in the Golden State Athletic Conference standings with a 7-2-1 GSAC mark and an overall record of 9-6-2, Dodge will be looking for a continuation of success despite a fairly young 2009 roster. Losing five seniors, including Tom Culver and Jason Swift from the starting lineup, the Lions are fortunate to return nine starters and 13 total players from last year's team. Ranked as high as 14th during the season, the Lions dropped out of the top 25 by the end of the season and suffered two heartbreaking losses at the end, falling in overtime to APU, and being eliminated from the GSAC Tournament 3-2 by the eventual tournament champion Westmont College. Dodge is hoping that the experienced returners can combine with his new recruits to produce a very successful 2009 season. "Last year was a year of change for Vanguard soccer," says Dodge. "We changed our style and formations and were just inches away from our second GSAC title. Our goal this year is to finish in the top 4 in GSAC again and to get the chance to go to nationals. We have a really young team, but one that has a lot of experience of playing at a high level. I think we will surprise a lot of teams."
