2009 Season Outlook

The 2008 VU Lions were extremely young but got off to a terrific start to the season, going 5-0-1 in the 1st six games. However, the rest of the season was up and down as the Lions lost 3 of six overtime games including the GSAC Postseason Tournament opener to end the year. Following the program's first victory at 5th-ranked APU (3-1), the Lions were eliminated from the playoffs as The Master's beat them 2-1 in overtime. Returning nine starters from last year's team, the Lions should be ready to pick up where they left off in 2008. "We have a very seasoned team with great leaders and this is the year we want to jump into the top 3 in GSAC," says VU Head Coach Randy Dodge. "Being a top 25 program is also a goal for us this year, as we have been ranked the last 4 years." Time will tell if the 2008 youngsters have matured enough to return to the NAIA top 25 and meet their goals for 2009.
